INFORMATION COLLECTION

HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

The information collected is used solely for communicating with you as the intended party. We do not share or sell your personal information with external parties for marketing or any other purpose.

Occasionally, the mobile or messaging content consent (such as sending SMS or other communications) will be collected when participating in marketing or promotional programs. All the above categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third party.

We may use personal data for the following purposes:

- To provide and maintain our service, including monitoring the usage of our service.
- To manage your account and registration as a user of the Service.
- To manage the products you have purchased or contracted with us.
- To contact you by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, including mobile application notifications regarding updates or information related to services or products you have purchased.

- To provide news, special offers, and general information about other goods, services, or events similar to those you have already purchased or inquired about, unless you have opted not to receive such information.
 - To manage your requests and respond to inquiries.
 - All messages you send through the Service, whether via user-to-user messages or stored on our servers, may be retained for business purposes and service improvement.
